Plaintiff hereby files this Notice of Transcript Order and Statement of Issues on Appeal, pursuant to ARCAP 11(c)(3). This civil action has had zero oral proceedings. Plaintiff/Appellant intends to assert the fact that Plaintiff/Appellant handed the initial complaint and fee deferral application to a deputy of the Cochise County Superior Court Clerk on 4 October 2024 and it was stamped "RECEIVED" on 4 October 2024. On 8 October 2024, a duty judge granted the fee deferral application. On 9 October 2024, the clerk stamped the complaint as "FILED". All of the evidence can be found inside the official court written records, not excluding the

1 initial complaint, motion to dismiss, motion for leave to amend complaint, and
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3 motion for consideration. Plaintiff/Appellant hereby reincorporates everything from
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5 the “Notice of Appeal” that was filed on 21 March 2025 and reserves the right to
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7 bring up any issue on appeal that was stated in the Notice of Appeal, not excluding
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9 alleging that the initial complaint was properly filed on 4 October 2024 and this civil
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11 action was properly commenced on 4 October 2024, and alleging that this civil action
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13 was timely, and that the superior court erred in denying the motion for leave to amend
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15 the complaint on grounds that it was moot. Since there are zero oral proceedings,
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17 there are no oral proceedings to request a transcript for, and therefore it is impossible
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19 for the Plaintiff/Appellant to file any orders for such transcripts as they do not exist,
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21 therefore, Plaintiff/Appellant has not ordered any oral transcripts for any proceedings
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23 in this matter and the appeal thereof.
