29 On 25 April 2025, Plaintiff, Mr. Dalton-Webb, filed a “Pro Per Litigant(s)
30 Electronic Distribution”, formally requesting service by e-mail from this Court and
31 its Clerk. Mr. Dalton-Webb has received service from this Court via physical mail
32 instead of e-mail at least twice after 25 April 2025 and before 2 July 2025.

37 On 2 July 2025, Plaintiff made a second request to this Court and its Clerk to
38 e-mail Plaintiff instead of being physically mailing Plaintiff with court-generated
39 documents (i.e. court orders). The Court issued an order (signed 31 July 2025, file-
40 stamped 5 August 2025) “CONFIRMING Plaintiff filed Notice of Electronic

1 Plaintiff has once again been physically mailed via USPS snail-mail the

3 “ORDER REASSIGNING MATTER” (file-stamped on 6 October 2025) instead of

5 be e-mailed. Plaintiff is concerned that he will be mailed important items from this

7 Court in the future and that Plaintiff will be prejudiced by the delays in postal service.

9 Plaintiff hereby requests from the Clerk of this Court to be e-mailed Court documents

11 at dw4az@proton.me (this e-mail address has not changed). With the Christmas

13 shopping frenzy coming, the USPS will be hiring massive amounts of new
14
15 employees, which Plaintiff has observed causes the USPS to become slower and
16
17 more unreliable with more lost mail at the end of the year.

20 This Court, on its order signed on 31 July 2025 and stamped 5 August 2025,

22 has previously ordered the Clerk to e-mail copies of Court documents to Plaintiff.

24 Plaintiff hereby requests a similar order again, ordering the Clerk to e-mail Plaintiff a

26 copy of the “ORDER REASSIGNING MATTER”.
