- (1) She is the Chief Counsel for the Industrial Commission of Arizona;
- (2) She has personal knowledge of the contents of ICA Claims and ALJ files;
- (3) Both Claims and ALJ filed contain sensitive personal information, including medical and financial information;
- (4) Medical information contained in the claims files often involves conditions unrelated to and not part of the workers' compensation matter;
- (5) Claims and ALJ files are confidential by both rule and statute;
- (6) ICA Claims employees do not adjudicate any disputes, but make initial findings subject to adjudication by an ALJ;
- (7) Hearings involve evidence and testimony that contain personal medical and financial information as provided in the Claims files; allowing public access to hearings would be akin to allowing public access to the Claim file and all the confidential information contained therein;
- (8) Allowing public access to hearings would compromise an ALJ's ability to effectively control the conduct of the hearing, distract from the evidence and testimony, and have a chilling effect on parties' desire to pursue a hearing.

This is not intended to be a comprehensive and all-encompassing categorization of testimony. This witness may testify in response to any and all evidence and testimony presented by Plaintiff, and on other issues that may arise during the course of the hearing.
